## “WE DON’T HAVE TRAGEDIES — WE HAVE TRIALS.”

### **READ**

*Romans 8:28, Job 13:15*

God is asking, “Can you just let Me work things out? Don’t forget that I sent My own Son to suffer for you, that My will might come to pass! I know where you are; I know what’s happening. Can you just bear for a little while?” The things we see are only temporary, but those we cannot see are eternal! God hasn’t forsaken you; He’s working all things out for His glory and your good. Are you complaining or murmuring during this? Do you really trust Him? As believers, we don’t have tragedies — we have trials. While He’s working things out, and you can’t see it: just trust Him. Remember that Paul and Silas were in prison and in chains, suffering, but at midnight they were still singing and praising! We may have to do some suffering.
