“PRAYING, TRUSTING PEOPLE CANNOT MISS GOD’S WILL.”

READ

Isaiah 43:1-3, Hebrews 13:5-6

Even if you feel like you’re 1,000 miles from where you ought to be, and you think you took a wrong turn, if you acknowledge the Lord, He will guide your steps. You may not be in the wrong place — it may just feel that way. God is with you. God is not up in heaven isolated from you. In your situation, right now, God is with you. For those of you who can’t even claim you’re saved, if God weren’t with you, working on you right now, you wouldn’t be reading this book. If you say, “Jesus is my Lord,” God is not far away.
