Preparation for Passover

Luke 22:7 Then came the first day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. 8 And He sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat it." 9 And they said to Him, "Where do You want us to prepare it?" 10 And He said to them, "Behold, when you have entered the city, a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him into the house that he enters. 11 "And you shall say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher says to you, "Where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?" 12 "And he will show you a large, furnished, upper room; prepare it there." 13 And they departed and found everything just as He had told them; and they prepared the Passover.

1 Corinthians 5:6 Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? 7 Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Messiah, our Passover was sacrificed for us. 8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

First Cup - The Cup of Sanctification

I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. (Exodus 6:6)

Hebrew Blessing: Ba-ruch atah A-do-nai Elo-hei-nu Me-lech Ha-Olam Bo-ray Pree Ha-gaw-fen.

Translation: Blessed are you, O Lord our God, King of the Universe, Creator of the fruit of the vine.

Second Cup - The Cup of Plagues

I will rescue you from their bondage. (Exodus 6:6)

Exodus 4:22 Then you shall say to Pharaoh, 'Thus says the LORD, Israel is My first-born son. **23** And I say to you, 'Let My son go that he may serve Me.' If you refuse to let him go, behold, I will kill your firstborn son.

Exodus 12:3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, "On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers' households, a lamb for each household. 5 Your lamb shall be an unblemished male.

6 And you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight. 7 Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it... **13** 'And the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt."

Third Cup - The Cup of Redemption

I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments (Exodus 6:7)

Hebrew Blessing: Ba-ruch atah A-do-nai Elo-hei-nu Me-lech Ha-Olam Ha- motzti Le-chem Min Ha-aw-rets.

Translation: Blessed are you, O Lord our God, King of the Universe, Who brings forth bread from the ground.

Luke 22:19 And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 20 And in the same way He took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the New Covenant in My blood."

Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a New Covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. 32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. 33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 34 No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.

Fourth Cup - The Cup of Hallel or Praise

I will take you as My people (Exodus 6:7)
