“I WANT TO SET MY FACE LIKE A FLINT.”

READ

Psalm 101, Isaiah 50:7

Our conversation should not be about all of the chatter and foolishness of this world. My tongue is sanctified. Scripture says that He touched my tongue with a coal from the altar of heaven. My tongue ought to sing the praises of God, and I ought to speak like a child of God. It's not just about my tongue, it's also about my eyes. I will not let my eyes land on anything that will take away from the beauty of Jesus, or keep me from walking with the Lord. If you really want to walk with Christ and conduct yourself in holiness, you must turn your eyes from looking at worthless things. You must let your gaze be directly in front of you. The spirit of compromise and the spirit of turning away is among us. Knowing these are the last days, I want to set my face like a flint.
