## “WALK IN HUMILITY.”

### **READ**

*Micah 6:6-8*

When we humble ourselves in the sight of the Lord, the power of the shed blood of Jesus is activated. One of the ways we can be most like Jesus is to walk in humility. Jesus, as our example, humbled Himself before God, laid down His life, and trusted His future to the Father. He allowed His blood to be shed to save us from our sins. He knew that he who humbles himself before God will be exalted. Because Jesus humbled Himself, God has given Him a name above every name. With Jesus as our example, we too must come to God in humility, covered with the powerful blood of Jesus. What is it that God wants from us? He wants us to do the right thing.
