“EVERY DAY IS RESURRECTION DAY.”

READ

I Corinthians 15:3-5

The important word in that passage is “seen.” This is not a myth, an illusion, or a religious thought. This is a reality, it’s factual and provable. Understand that these disciples became so emboldened by the fact that He appeared to them that they were ready to become martyrs. Those disciples that hid behind closed doors, ran for their lives, and forsook their Master, now became brazen preachers of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It was not an illusion to them. They were not trying to keep a dream alive. It was a reality, a fulfillment of Holy Scripture and they, with their own eyes, saw the risen Jesus. The Resurrection means absolutely nothing if, when you get up every morning, you are defeated and discouraged, full of sorrow and weeping. Jesus Christ is alive and seated right now at the right hand of our Father. You should wake up every day and say because He lives I live also. He is alive and He is alive forevermore.

PRAY

Jesus, I thank You today that, without any doubt, You are alive. You died once, You rose once, and You live forever. Praise God for the resurrection — Yours and mine.
