“A DETERMINED HEART HAS A STRONG PRAYER LIFE.”

READ

Luke 18:1-5 and 8

“Men ought always to pray.” Does the Bible really mean that? “Always?” Does it mean that our whole life is to be consumed by prayer? Yes, it does. “Men ought always to pray and not lose heart.” A weak heart means a weak prayer life. A determined heart means a strong prayer life. Can you grasp that?
