### **READ**

*Psalm 139:7-12*

Are you sitting there scratching your chin wondering, “How did I get here?” Are you a child of God? Then I can tell you how you got there: He led you there. Are you wondering, “Did I make the wrong turn back there? Should I be over here?” It is God that does the leading. I don’t know how it works. God is sovereign and yet, I’m responsible.
